Statement:

Painting is an inner process for me. I enter the studio without a plan, let go of everything, and listen inward. From that moment, I begin to paint. Depending on my mood, something powerful and dark may emerge, or something soft and almost silent. I work with high-quality, pigment-rich acrylics and use fluorescent and neon colors that unfold a special luminosity depending on the light. I'm not searching for depiction or concept, but for atmosphere, emotion, and depth.

My work is deeply connected to my inner world. It speaks of longing, vulnerability, strength, and transformation. Often, the paintings evolve intuitively, but sometimes they begin with a specific emotion. Anger, disappointment, or overwhelm may become the starting point for color, gesture, and form. The canvas becomes a space of resonance. I'm not looking for answers but for moments that can be felt. Sometimes I paint the world more beautiful than it is. Not to escape reality, but to offer something in response to it. I hope my work creates a space – a space for stillness, reflection, and a quiet connection to one's own feelings.

In recent years, my painting has also expanded into the digital realm. Some of my works now exist as animated images on the blockchain, as NFTs. This evolution adds movement, light, and a new dimension of resonance to the paintings. What began as an intuitive brushstroke becomes a flowing visual rhythm in the digital space. The emotional intensity remains – only the form of expression changes.

About

The focus of Sophia Kühn's painting is the sea and the sky in their ever-changing appearance. At least, that's how it seems at first glance.

A key aspect that distinguishes Sophia Kühn from many other artists dedicated to this theme is her sense of temporality. What is meant here is that Sophia Kühn brings to the canvas a perspective that could be called timeless. It's not about capturing a singular, unique moment, as Hokusai did when he showed us the wave just before it breaks. Rather, she succeeds in using color and light to create an atmosphere that detaches itself from the motif. The sea we see now was just a moment ago something else and will continue to change before our eyes. But it is less reality that causes this change. It is the eye of the beholder, the gaze of the individual, who moves through the world with ever-changing emotions, creating their own realities.

Of course, this is no longer provocative, as it was in William Turner's time, when he dared to break away from the motif and painted atmospheric landscapes bordering on abstraction. Yet these paintings, in which the interplay between the concrete and the abstract is constantly redefined, question the reality of the visible.

To call Sophia Kühn a landscape painter would therefore be too simplistic, as she continually explores the boundaries of this genre – sometimes with broad, gestural brushstrokes, sometimes with translucent layers of color. Here, a whirl of vibrant, broad brushstrokes evokes cloud formations or gusts of wind. There, it's intersecting color fields that suggest sky and sea only because of a horizon delicately indicated with a fine line. In this way, her painting becomes a tool for exploring emotions.

Viewing the sea becomes a projection surface for the self, which cannot see itself but expresses its innermost being through the motif. What could be more fitting for this than the infinite vastness of the sea and sky, which remind humanity of its insignificance? After all, we are nothing more than a speck of dust in the universe. And yet, the vastness of the sea and sky always carries something comforting for us."

In the "Coast" series, I capture fleeting moments by the sea – the play of the waves, the wind tugging at the kites, the carefree laughter of children, or the silence of a solitary walker. Soft clouds weave sky and sea into a gentle, expansive backdrop. 




Series: Golden

Here, gold takes center stage. I work intuitively, letting colors flow and placing golden accents with intention to bring the painting to life. The works change with the light – sometimes they shimmer softly, other times they shine with intensity. This mutability fascinates me, as it gives the paintings a unique dynamic that never stands still. Gold represents warmth, depth, and something timeless – and that's exactly what my painting reflects.











Series: Red

This series is an expression of intense emotions – unrestrained, stirring, and powerful. Red dominates my works: sometimes blazing and fiery, sometimes deep and earthy, sometimes radiant and pulsating. Some paintings are inspired by the great fires of recent years – by their destructive force, but also by the unstoppable renewal they bring. Others emerge from deeply felt emotions that erupt freely onto the canvas. My painting process is intuitive and direct – every movement, every stroke carries the energy of the moment.

Series: Untamed

In "Untamed", I follow a purely intuitive painting process – without limitations, without rules. Expressive brushstrokes, impulsive bursts of color, and bold contrasts define my works. I let myself be guided by my energy, by emotions that unfold unrestrained on the canvas. My painting is wild, untamed – a play between chaos and harmony, an expression of pure freedom.

Series: Neon / Fluorescent

In these works, I experiment with light and color in a very special way. I use neon and fluorescent tones selectively, which make the painting appear completely different depending on the environment. Under normal lighting, they reveal their intense luminosity, but under black light, the artwork transforms – new layers, hidden structures, and glowing accents emerge. This effect fascinates me, as it makes each piece dynamic, almost alive. My intuitive, expressionist approach leaves room for surprise and transformation – just like the light, which continually re-creates the art.
